



Trumbull Library System Exhibits and Displays Policy

Since it is part of the Trumbull Library's function to provide access to intellectual and cultural resources for the community, the exhibit areas in the Trumbull Library shall be used for artistic, cultural, and informational purposes, and not for personal profit, in keeping with these Library goals.

Exhibits of Trumbull Library materials and activities will be given first consideration. Local artists, community organizations and individuals are encouraged to offer exhibits of artistic, cultural or informational merit. Persons or groups outside of Trumbull are invited to exhibit when their work would be of general interest to the Trumbull community and the display case is not being used by Trumbull organizations or individuals.

The Library is not responsible and will not be held liable for any items owned by the exhibitor(s) while they are in the possession of the Library.

All exhibitors are required to agree to and to follow the Trumbull Library's Exhibits Displays Policy guidelines. The Library Director will make final decisions regarding display material.

This policy and the implementation guidelines are subject to continuous review. Suggestions from the community regarding use of the exhibit areas in the Library are welcome.

This policy is subject to change at the discretion of the Trumbull Library Board of Trustees.
